


The **triggers** guarantee optimum **synchronization** whatever the patient's age or profile.

With its self-adjusting system, Monnal T50 maintains its full **sensitivity** for any actual leakage level.




Easy Valve

The expiratory valve is integrated into the ventilator for better protection. To **switch** from double to single-limb circuit, just press a button to eject the **expiratory valve**.





For a patient with a neuromuscular condition and a tracheostomy, the **Boost** function provides the following advantages every day:
